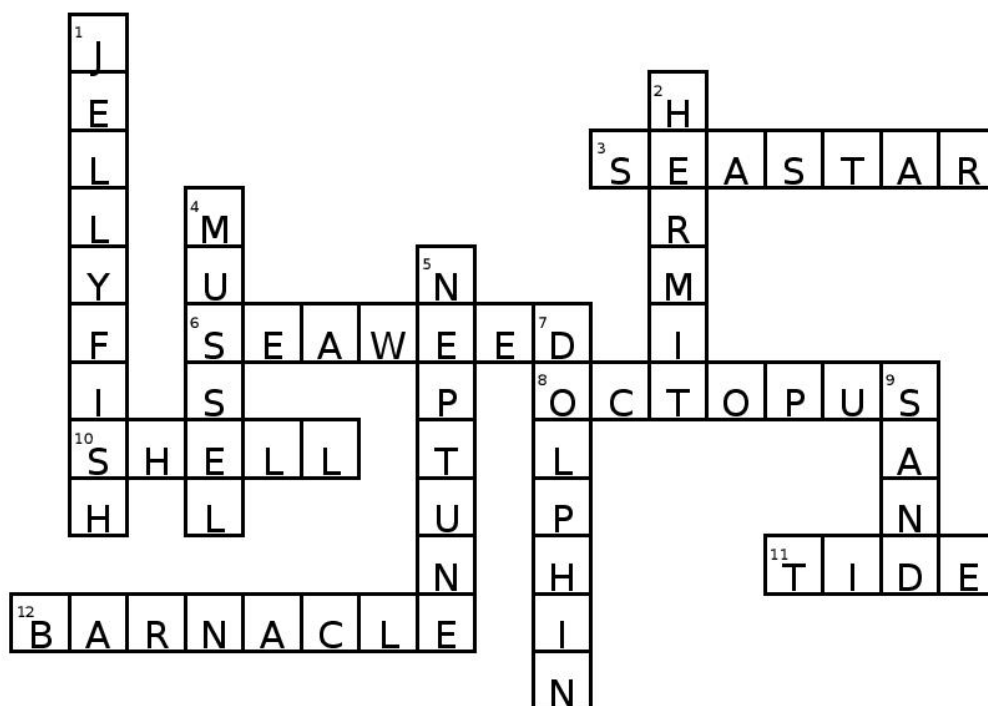


Seashore Crossword



Down:

- I have a see-through body and float around in the sea. (9)
- A crab that likes to live in empty shells. As it grows it moves to bigger shells where it hides from predators. (6)
- My two shells are dark blue and stuck together. I cling to rocks and when the sea covers me, I open up and filter feed which also helps to clean the water. (6)
- Mythical God of the sea. Also the name of a type of seaweed that looks like a necklace. (7)
- I am a sea mammal and I eat fish. I am grey and use sonar to navigate. (6)
- Fine particles of rock found along beaches. It is made of quartz or silica and usually white or yellow in colour. (4)

Across:

- I look like a star, live in rock pools and am often beautifully coloured. (7)
- I am a sea plant. I can be green, brown or red. I am also called algae. (7)
- I live on the sea floor and under rocks. I have tentacles with suckers and large eyes. (7)
- I am made for protection by many sea animals. I come in many different shapes and sizes. (5)
- The rise and fall of the waters of the ocean, about every twelve hours, due to the pull of the moon and the sun. (4)
- I am a shellfish found on rocks in the tidal zone and also on the bottom of boats. (8)
