Cloze Activity Solutions (level 1)

Giant Australian Cuttlefish

The Giant Australian Cuttlefish is not a type of fish but belongs to the **CEPHALOPOD** family. This is the same class of animals that squid and **OCTOPUS** belong to. A cuttlefish has 8 **ARMS** and 2 feeding tentacles. Cuttlefish have 3 hearts and **BLUE** blood. Cuttlefish are a master of disguise, meaning they can change the colour and **TEXTURE** of their skin.

Sea Country – Firesticks

Fire is an important part of Aboriginal culture and is used in many ways. Fire can be used to stay warm, and to **COOK** food. It can be used to tell **STORIES**, in ceremonies and used in medicines. Fire can be made from **FLINT** and pyrites that were found in the area.

Plastic Pollution

It has been estimated that 12 million tonnes of **PLASTIC** will enter our oceans every year. Rubbish can be transported from the land to the ocean in many ways, including by the wind and by **ANIMALS** carrying it. Pieces of plastic pollution can **HARM** animals such as turtles, whales, and **SEA BIRDS**.
