



Sea Country - Boomerangs – Cloze Activity Solutions (Level 2)

In Karna language the boomerang is called a **Wadna**. The Boomerang was designed by the **First** Scientists who were clever Indigenous explorers and **inventors** of their time, figuring out how things worked in the world around them. The Boomerang was invented to be **aerodynamic** with their rounded edges and **wide** surface area. This shape allows Boomerangs to **glide** through the air with ease and they even inspired the idea for modern aeroplane **wings**. Some Boomerangs were designed to be used for **hunting**, where they were aimed at the legs of kangaroos and **emus**. Some were made to be larger for use in battles or for protection while others were used as a **musical** instrument, being tapped together to create a rhythmic harmony.
