



What makes a Reef – Cloze Activity Solutions (Level 1)

Reefs are like an underwater **city**, and they can be found all around the world's coastlines as well as underwater. Reefs can be made up of **rocks** or stony corals. In **warm** tropical waters the reefs are built by tiny animals called coral **polyps**. In the Great Southern Reefs, the cooler **temperate** waters are filled with seaweed covered rocks. A reef can be **natural** and made of rocks and corals, or they can be artificial, created by humans with materials such as old **tyres** or sunken ships.
