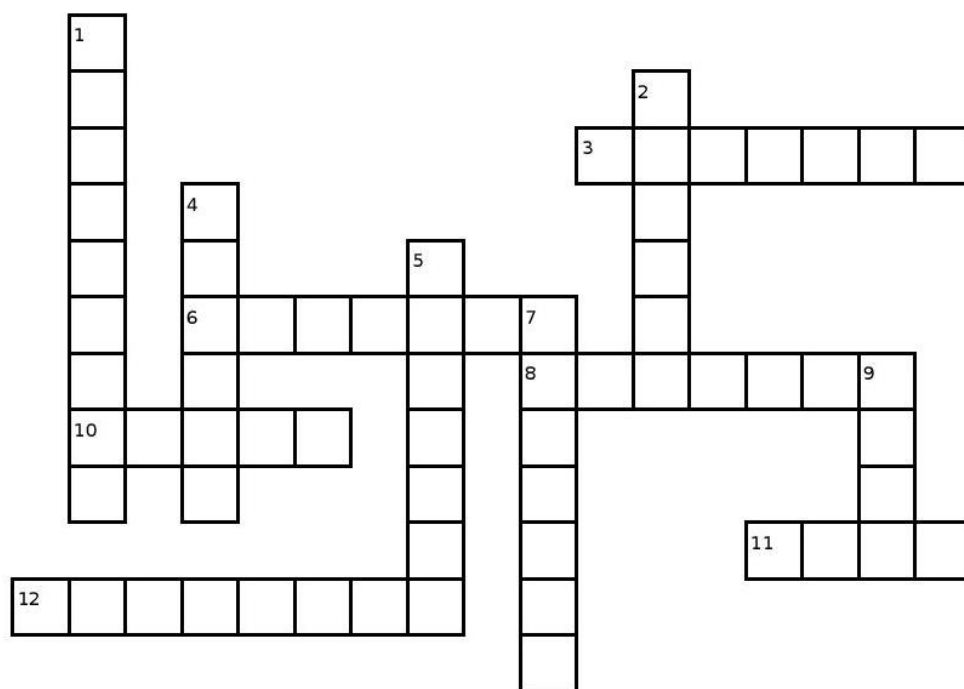


Seashore Crossword



Down:

1. I have a see-through body and float around in the sea. (9)
2. A crab that likes to live in empty shells. As it grows it moves to bigger shells where it hides from predators. (6)
4. My two shells are dark blue and stuck together. I cling to rocks and when the sea covers me, I open up and filter feed which also helps to clean the water. (6)
5. Mythical God of the sea. Also the name of a type of seaweed that looks like a necklace. (7)
7. I am a sea mammal and I eat fish. I am grey and use sonar to navigate. (6)
9. Fine particles of rock found along beaches. It is made of quartz or silica and usually white or yellow in colour. (4)

3. I look like a star, live in rock pools and am often beautifully coloured. (7)
6. I am a sea plant. I can be green, brown or red. I am also called algae. (7)
8. I live on the sea floor and under rocks. I have tentacles with suckers and large eyes. (7)
